Distinguished Participating Teams of Butra HeidelbergCement Tour de Brunei 2011

Ladies and Gentlemen.

Assalamu'alaikum Warahmatullahi Wabarakatuh
and very good afternoon.

1. First and foremost, on behalf of the Government of His Majesty the Sultan dan Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam, I would like to warmly welcome the officials and participants of the Butra HeidelbergCement Tour de Brunei 2011.
